JOIN OUR SUMMER BASKETBALL LEAGUE

RNA, in conjunction with the Jersey City Department of Recreation and Cultural Affairs, is sponsoring a summer basketball league in Riverview-Fisk Park. The league will begin July 10th and run through August 11th, from 5 P.M. to 9 P.M., Monday through Friday.

The teams will be divided into three divisions:

- 1) Bidy (ages 10 - 13)
- 2) Junior (ages 14 - 17)
- 3) Senior (age 18 and over).

Anyone interested in participating, is encouraged to sign up now with Jose Fontanez, the site manager, at the court between 5 and 7 PM.

The league will provide structured recreational activities for our neighborhood youth and young adults. It also provides an opportunity to develop coaching and leadership skills.

THE RIVERVIEW COMMUNITY GARDENS

RNA has formally inaugurated its community gardens program in Riverview-Fisk Park. The fenced-in garden, which is divided in many individual plots, is located on Ogden Avenue, north of Griffith Street. The garden was created to promote community spirit and a sense of commitment for our neighborhood.

To be eligible for a plot of land to grow flowers or vegetables: you must live in the nearby area and agree to look after your plot for the entire growing season. There will be local gardeners on hand to offer advice and growing suggestions, but each allotment holder will be responsible for their own patch. There will be at least one plot for young people, under the age of 17.
