## **Community Updates**

All American Recycling Plant: This is the recycling plant at the base of the Palisade Cliffs at 2 Hope Street, referred to by residents as "Ponte's Recycling". At the last RNA meeting numerous complaints were voiced about noise coming from this plant, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Thanks goes to councilman-at-large, Peter Brennan, who attended the RNA meeting and contacted several local authorities about the noise problem. The Hudson Regional Noise Control contacted the owner and the results are: 1) back-up beepers on equipment have been replaced with strobe lights - except for two units that are on back order, 2) maintenance was performed on a conveyor belt, 3) speed bumps at the weighing scale will be removed (this was creating the loud banging noises of the metal containers and lids) and 4) drivers and machinery operators were instructed to keep operations quiet. If further disturbing noises are created, please note the type of noise, the day and time.

**Riverview-Fisk Park Playground:** The renovation of the playground is on schedule and is expected to be completed in the first part of November.

**Street Paving:** In this section of the Heights, mostly between Palisade and Central Avenues there are new catch basins and sidewalk handicapped access ramps being installed. This is a prelude to the much needed street repaving that will begin about October 10th and be completed at the end of November.

The Cliffs project: The review of the vibration monitoring plan by a second party has been completed. The conclusion of the report is that the plan to be used in the monitoring of vibrations as the cliff face is drilled into for the installation of retaining rods is "reasonable and satisfactory" and complies with the U. S. Office of Surface Mining criteria. On October 7th, RNA met at the site with the developer and Langan Engineering that is overseeing the Cliff work. The preliminary investigation work has not been completed at the north end of the site, but at this time overall results indicate that there is no need for any major changes in the Cliff Stabilization Plan that was originally presented. The two test bores in the area of the retaining wall to be rebuilt on the Cliff face show that original design of the new retaining wall is still appropriate for the site conditions. More detailed information concerning the Cliff work adjacent to your property and a 30 day construction schedule will be available at the RNA meeting.
